The General Class amateur radio license permits you to use the segments of every worldwide band for long-distance voice, data, and video amateur communications. You will also be able to use *EchoLink* or IRLP to converse with hams on the other side of the world. No longer is Morse code a requirement for the FCC license. Now you can upgrade your Technician Class license in a two-weekend course conducted by the Intercity Amateur Radio Club (IARC) of Mansfield, We hope you make the decision to upgrade by registering for our class today.

FCC Element 3 Course:

The Element 3 theory exam has been dramatically improved in content, better reflecting General Class worldwide radio equipment and antennas. No longer will you need to memorize difficult formulas that you would rarely use. There is more emphasis on operating, band plans, data modes, and high frequency antennas to build. The course is conducted over two weekends and concludes Sunday afternoon with the 35-question multiple-choice FCC exam. Five experienced Amateur Radio Extra and General Class instructors conduct the class and the testing.
